GENERAL RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. For safety reasons, all children who are unable to swim must be accompanied and monitored by a responsible individual.
2. All patrons must follow the directions of the pool staff.
3. Persons who have stomach/intestinal infections or open sores are not permitted to swim as mandated by the Pennsylvania Department of Health.
4. Glass containers are not permitted.
5. Keep food and drink away from pool area.
6. Distracting the lifeguards will not be tolerated.
7. The pool is not responsible for any valuables or personal property brought into the facility.
8. **NO running, active sports, ball playing, pushing, rough housing, or lewd behavior.**
9. **NO profane, crude, or obscene language regardless of age.**
10. **Any incidence of fighting will result in ejection from the facility.**
11. **Disobeying pool staff WILL NOT be tolerated.**
12. **Use of tobacco, alcohol, and drugs are prohibited.**
13. **Anyone caught stealing; destroying or defacing pool property will be subject to prosecution.**

***Zero Tolerance: All items in bold may result in ejection from the facility, no warning necessary.**

1st offense ---- Warning
2nd offense ---- Ejection from pool for the day
3rd offense ---- Ejection until permitted to return to
the pool at the pool manager's discretion

Anyone who has been dismissed from the pool for disciplinary reasons may have their pool pass revoked for the remainder of the season without a refund.

DIVING BOARD

1. Only one person is permitted on the diving board at a time.
2. Diving is only permitted in the diving well.
3. After diving, please exit diving area immediately.
4. No reverse dives.

WADING POOL

1. The wading pool is restricted to use for children 8 years of age and under and the handicapped. Children must be monitored by a responsible individual.
2. Children in diapers are required to wear swim diapers.

CLOSING POLICY

During the season the pool may close for various reasons, including but not limited to, the following:

- Inclement weather or home swim meet
- In the event of thunder and/or lightning while the pool is open, swimmers will be required to remain clear of the pool for 30 minutes after the last sighting of lightning or clap of thunder.
